

Boro House, Poole, Dorset

The Scheme

Boro House was remodelled into a supported living house of multiple occupation for adults with learning disabilities in 2005. In total there are six individual bedrooms with shared living areas including a lounge, kitchen and two bathrooms. There is also a paved patio courtyard area outside the property. Ideally situated in central Poole, Boro House is close to all town centre facilities.

Services

As a supported living property customers at Boro House receive regular visits from a Team of trained Learning Disability Support Workers. All support is tailored to individual's needs with individual support plans determining the frequency of support visits. In addition, all flats are fitted with a Careline unit, allowing tenants to access help in an emergency 24 hours a day, every day of the year.
