The Scheme

Furzey Flats was built in 2008 to provide supported living accommodation for adults with learning disabilities. In total there are 4 x selfcontained one bedroom flats: two ground floor, two first floor.

The scheme also benefits from a communal conservatory lounge looking out onto a patio area and the communal gardens. Adjacent to Pergins, another of the Trust's schemes, Furzey is close to Poole town centre facilities.

Services

As a supported living property tenants at Furzey Flats receive regular visits from a team of trained Learning Disability Support Workers.

All support is tailored to individual's needs with individual support plans determining the frequency of support visits, with 24 hour support provided.

In addition, all flats are fitted with a Careline unit, allowing tenants to access help in an emergency 24 hours a day, every day of the year.
